Kate is the Senior Chief of Staff at Nine News Melbourne, where she has been at the helm of breaking news since 2011. With more than two decades working across Melbourne TV newsrooms, Kate was previously a senior reporter then Chief of Staff at Ten News. She is also on the board of the Melbourne Press Club, St Vincent's hospital foundation and the Monash journalism school advisory board.
